VISAS

Western Sydney University will issue successful applicants with an electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCoE) that they can use to lodge an application for the Student Visa (subclass 500).

Students cannot study with us on the Working Holiday Visa (subclass 417) or the Work and Holiday Visa (subclass 462).

HEALTH INSURANCE

It is a visa requirement that almost all students purchase Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) insurance. Exceptions are:

- → Belgian students covered under the Reciprocal Health Care Agreement with Australia
- → Norwegian students covered by the Norwegian National Insurance Scheme
- → Swedish students covered by Kammarkollegiet


