

Visas

Upon receiving your admission letter from KMITL, you can start to go about getting your visa to enter Thailand. As an international student, you will be required to obtain a "non-immigrant 'ED' visa" to study in the country. In order to acquire an 'ED' visa, you will need to bring the following documents to your local Royal Thai Embassy or Royal Thai Consulate:

- Visa application form
- Admission letter from KMITL
- Passport with a validity of not less than six months
- Two recent, full-face photographs (4x6 cm)
- Evidence of adequate finance (20,000 Baht per person and 40,000 Baht per family or as determined by the Royal Thai Embassy)

Validity of Visa

- Single-entry visa: 3 months
- Multiple-entry visa: up to one year

Unless instructed otherwise by the Office of Immigration Bureau, all ED-visa applicants are initially given a visa valid for 90 days only, after which they can apply for an extension of up to a year (from their date of arrival into Thailand).

IMPORTANT: The date written on your visa is the date before which you must enter the country. If you have a multiple-entry visa, you must make your FINAL entry before this date.

Health Insurance

All students are required to purchase insurance covering the exchange period (from the home country)
