Dear student, please note that you need a Letter of Acceptance from us for the Ernst Mach application. As it may take some time to check the documents, it is best to send them to us (tina.gsenger@fh-salzburg.ac.at) as soon as possible. After applying for the Ernst Mach scholarship, you also need to apply to the FH Salzburg as an exchange student (Incoming Application).

**** DOCUMENT PACKAGE 2**

(necessary for you to be able to apply for the Ernst Mach scholarship):		✓
1	<p>Two <u>letters of recommendation</u> by university lecturers</p> <p>-they must contain the <u>letterhead, date and signature</u> of the person recommending the applicant</p> <p>-the <u>stamp of the university</u> / department</p> <p>-must <u>not be older than six months</u> at the time of application</p>	
2	<p>Confirmation from your <u>home university</u> that the courses completed at FH Salzburg will be recognized by your home university (at least 15 ECTS)</p> <p>-(e.g. a Learning Agreement) - with stamp of the university and signature</p> <p>OR</p> <p>-template “confirmation courses/exams recognized by home university” (including stamp, letter head of home university, signature and date)</p>	
3	<u>Confirmation of Acceptance/Letter of Acceptance</u> (from FH Salzburg)	
4	Scan of valid <u>passport</u> (page with the name and photo)	
5	Scan of a previous and <u>current Transcript of Records</u> from your study cycle with logo of the home institution to prove that it is official and if possible, please include a stamp or seal from the home institution (<i>to prove at least 4 semesters are completed bevor going abroad</i>)	

Reasons why applications were rejected for formal reasons:

- The wrong ERNST MACH grant program was chosen – make sure to select the one for Universities of Applied Sciences
- The application form was not completely filled
- Documents were missing (eg. Transcript of Records)
- Recommendation letter did not contain the students' name / University stamp or letter head
- Recommendation letter was not dated or signed, did not wear the official letterhead of the home university
- Academic transcript not in English language, or not signed and stamped
- Duration of studies in the application form differed from acceptance letter
- Documents were **not dated/signed/stamped** accordingly.
- Passport was missing or not valid
- No evidence that classes taken in Austria will count towards your degree back home (*Learning Agreement OR letter or recognition*)
- Application form was filled, but not submitted
