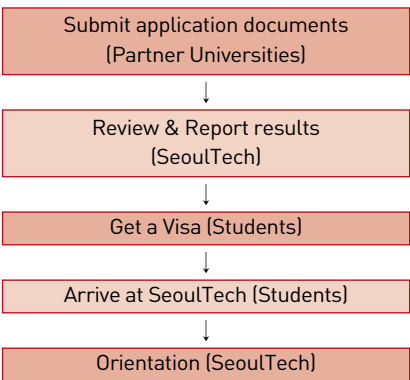
Exchange Student Program SeoulTech International Season Semester

Exchange Student Program(ESP)

Information

- **Eligibility**
 - Full time student currently enrolled in the partner universities
 - Those who can study courses delivered either in English or Korean
- **Program Period**
 - 1 semester or 1 academic year
- **Application Deadline**
 - Fall(September~December) semester : May 31
 - Spring(March~June) semester : November 30
- **Require Documents**
 - An official transcript, a study plan essay, etc.

Application Procedures



SeoulTech International Season Semester(STISS)

Information

- **Description**

A program intended for the partner universities' students to learn Korean language and understand Korean culture through special lectures, and field trip at SeoulTech
- **Credits** : 2 academic credits awarded upon completion
- **Timetable**
 - AM : Korean Language Courses
 - PM : Special Lectures or Half Day Field Trip
- **Participants** : 90 in total(up to three from each university)
- **Period** : July ~ August
- **Benefits** : All free including tuition, dormitory, meals, field trip and airport pick-up service EXCEPT for air-fare

Program Contents

- **Basic Korean Language**
- **Special Lectures**

Korean Movie Class, Korean Music Class, Taekwondo Class, Korean Traditional Instrument Class, etc
- **Excursion**

Traditional Costume(Hanbok) Experience, NANTA Show, etc





Korean Language & Culture Program

Korean Language & Culture Program(KLCP)

Information

- **Objectives**
 - To advance Korean language skills for the full academic courses
 - To understand Korean culture for international students
- **Eligibility** : A high school diploma or equivalent
- **Terms & Hours**
 - 4 terms (Spring, Summer, Fall and Winter)
 - 200 hours for 10 weeks (per semester)
- **Class days** : Monday to Friday 9:00~13:00
- **Tuition** : approx. USD 1,000 (per semester)

Require Documents

- An application form
- A copy of passport
- A copy of the certificate of graduation and a notarized official transcript (translated either in Korean or English)
- An original certified bank statement of the applicant's account (USD 5,000 or higher)
- An application fee of KRW 50,000(non-refundable)

Class Levels

Level 1 ~ 2 (Beginner)	• Basic communication tasks needed in daily life • Basic Korean culture
Level 3 ~ 4 (Intermediate)	• Basic communication tasks needed in social functions • Minimum Korean skills essential for a Korean university • Various components of Korean culture
Level 5 ~ 6 (Advanced)	• Natural communication tasks in daily life and in social functions • Deep understanding of Korean culture and history
