

Hokkaido Summer Institute (HSI) 2022 website is opened [Hokkaido University, JAPAN]



Dear Partners,

Greeting from Hokkaido University, Japan!

We are glad to inform you that Hokkaido Summer Institute (HSI) 2022 information was released on the website in mid-February.

More than 160 world-leading researchers from overseas will provide lectures with the university's faculty members for five months during the summer for the HSI, which was established in 2016 and more than 1,000 international students have participated so far.

From 2020, we also accept applications from non-students.

There will be over 270 courses (around 220 graduate courses and around 50 undergraduate courses) from June 1st to October 31st, 2022.

Each course is worth 1 academic credit. Most of the courses run for one or two weeks.

Students can tailor their own summer program by combining courses according to their major and interests.

From 2020, we also accept applications from non-students including working adults.

More than 160 courses will be open to non-students this year.

In 2022, HSI will launch eHSI which provides more options of online courses.

Applicants will be able to choose from 100 online courses.

Most of the courses offered online will also be available face-to-face at HU.

Participants may come to Japan and take face-to-face classes if the situations allow.

Tuition fee will be waived for students who enroll in the program as exchange students from HU's partner institutions

with which HU has concluded a departmental exchange agreement on mutual tuition waivers. Students are required to take at least one course organized by the HU department which your institution has concluded the agreement with.

The number of HSI students is not included in the exchange quota.

Program Outline

HSI 2022 will offer over 270 courses ranging from beginner to PhD level during the summer (June–October 2022). Many of the courses are 1 week–2 weeks in length. You can combine courses according to your major and interests.

If you cannot come to Japan due to the COVID-19-related travel restrictions, you may be able to take classes online. Please check the website for courses offered online.

Eligibility

- Degree-program students at universities (University-enrolled students)
- High school graduates / University graduates (Non-students)

Credit

1 credit will be awarded upon completion of each course.

Fees

Tuition fee: 14,800 JPY per credit

Notes:

- Tuition fee will be waived for students from 60+ partner institutions under certain conditions.
- Application Fee: 3,000 JPY and Entrance Fee: 28,200 JPY will be charged to Non-student applicants.

Online Application Periods

1st application: March 7th – 16th, 2022 (on weekend)
2nd application: June 1st – 7th, 2022
