

ERNST MACH GRANT_ Salzburg University of Applied Sciences

Dear partner,

We would like to remind you that the nomination deadline for the Ernst Mach grant for exchange students to FH SALZBURG is coming up! We kindly ask you to distribute this information in your institution, especially to academic staff and interested students.

The Austrian ministry of science and research offers the ERNST MACH grant for all students with a non-European citizenship who plan to come here for **fall 2022 or spring 2023** (or both). This grant would open the study abroad opportunity also for students who would normally not have the necessary financial background. With **1050 Euro a month**, this grant allows students to cover all their cost.

We would like to encourage interested students to apply for the ERNST MACH grant! The chances to get this grant are quite good if students submit a complete and thoughtful application. Please find our tips for a successful grant attached.

In order to apply, students and their home universities need to plan early though. We will need their nominations until 3rd February 2022 in order to prepare all documents accordingly. To make the process as easy as possible, please provide the data of nominated students in the following format:

The deadline for the grant application with the ministry will be **1 March 2022**, the start of their studies would be **September 2022** or February 2023.

There is only one call per year - 1 March 2022 is the application deadline for the entire academic period (fall and spring semester 2022/23). The minimum duration of the grant is 3 months, the maximum is 10 months.

I will be the contact person for the ERNST MACH candidates and will guide them through the online application process. The application portal is the following: <https://www.scholarships.at/>. Please note that your students may work on their applications before having received an official acceptance letter from us.

Please note:

The students nominated for the Ernst Mach Scholarship must also apply as incoming students of the [FH Salzburg](#); the students concerned will be informed separately.

We hope to receive many nominations from your side. Please do not hesitate to contact me if any questions should arise.
