You can open a bank account at any Post office or bank in Taiwan. 3. Please upload the cover page of the passbook that has your name and the account number.

3. For Scholarship Recipients, after you completed the enrollments and are approved by the OIA, OIA will then start issuing your first monthly stipend around 10-14 working days (Example: if your enrollment is approved by the OIA in the 2nd week of September, generally you will receive your stipend around the last week of September)

➤ **Years of Studies** 修業年限&畢業學分

The years of studies for master's programs may be 1 to 4 years.

The years of studies for doctoral programs may be 2 to 7 years.

➤ **Credit Waiver** 學分抵免

For professional courses, it shall be held by the respective departments of the applying students. Upon completion of the preliminary review, the Office of Academic Affairs will conduct the second review, and notify the students about the results.

➤ **Minimum English Proficiency Requirements for Graduation** 英語能力畢業門檻

- Each graduate student admitted to the Taipei Tech master's/doctoral program as of Academic Year 2019 must meet one of the following English proficiency test criteria to pass the minimum English proficiency requirements for graduation:
 - NTUT English Proficiency Test for Minimum Graduation Requirement Level A or Level B.
 - Scoring in accordance with CEFR Level B1 on English proficiency tests.
- Graduate students of the Special Foreign Students Programs are **exempt** from the minimum English proficiency requirements for graduation, and are subject to the policy of each special program.
- Graduate students in the English department are required to pass the minimum English proficiency

requirements for graduation under department policy.

➤ **Academic Research Ethics Education** 學術倫理教育

Each student of the master's/doctoral program in Taipei Tech shall complete the academic research ethics education courses by the end of the first year following the registration. Any student unable to complete the courses before the deadline shall meet the requirements no later than applying for the degree examination. Any student who fails to complete the academic research ethics education courses as required will not be eligible for taking the degree examination.

➤ **Credits for Graduation** 畢業學分

The total credit requirements for graduate students shall be prescribed by respective graduate schools. **Master's** students shall at least complete **24 course credits and 6 thesis credits**. **Doctoral** students shall at least complete **18 course credits and 12 thesis credits**. As may be required for their researches, graduate students may enroll in the undergraduate courses; the scores will not be included in the total average of that semester and upon graduation, and the units will not be counted against the graduation requirements.

➤ **Tuition & Dorm Bills** 學費&宿舍費

*****IMPORTANT*****

Students are strongly advised to complete all tuition and payments before deadline. Students who fail to pay their tuition and fees before the deadline will be penalized in accordance with university regulations and face the consequences of expulsion and deportation.

➤ **Health & Insurance** 健康保險

International students must register for health insurance during their stay in Taiwan. Students staying in Taiwan with a valid Alien Resident Certificate (ARC) for over six months continuously must enroll in National Health Insurance (NHI). Prior to registering for NHI, we will automatically enroll you in Group Medical Insurance.

Note: If you would like to use another insurance that you have purchased from your home country instead of joining Group Medical Insurance, you must have the insurance verified by the Taiwan Embassy/Mission in your home country.

The Group Medical Insurance fee is a one-time payment.
