Questions (Visa, Immigrations...etc)	<p>Taiwan procedures are the same with other non-visa-entry countries. A lot of students from other countries have the same experience.</p> <p>In details:</p> <p>In one day</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students come to Latvia and go to the RTU Admission Office <u>to sign the study contract.</u> They should have passport and bank statement confirming necessary subsistence (in English, with full name in Latin letters and passport number on it) with them; 2. At the Admission Office students <u>receive ORTUS (RTU study intranet) access</u> (starting with this moment all the information regarding studies will be sent there) <u>and letter to Riga Transport Office to get Student Public Transport Card;</u> <p>Up to one week</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3. Students should have: bank statement, dormitory or apartment rent agreement, valid health insurance policy; 4. Ms. Elina is making the appointment to the Office of Migration Affairs and is submitting all the documents herself; <p>30 days (100Eur) /10 days (200Eur)/ 5 days (400Eur) after the documents are submitted</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5. Students receive temporary residence permit <p>So the most favorable way - the longest (since it is the cheapest) procedure can take around 40 days. And in emergency case it can be done in 2 weeks.</p>
