> Minimum English Proficiency Requirements for Graduation

- Each graduate student admitted to the Taipei Tech master's/doctoral program as of Academic Year 2019 must meet one of the following English proficiency test criteria to pass the minimum English proficiency requirements for graduation:
 - (1) NTUT English Proficiency Test for Minimum Graduation Requirement Level A or Level B.
 - (2) Scoring in accordance with CEFR Level B1 on English proficiency tests.
- 2. Graduate students of the Special Foreign Students Programs are exempt from the minimum English proficiency requirements for graduation, and are subject to the policy of each special program.
- 3. Graduate students in the English department are required to pass the minimum English proficiency requirements for graduation under department policy.

> Academic Research Ethics Education

Each student of the master's/doctoral program in Taipei Tech shall complete the academic research ethics education courses by the end of the first year following the registration. Any student unable to complete the courses before the deadline shall meet the requirements no later than applying for the degree examination. Any student who fails to complete the academic research ethics education courses as required will not be eligible for taking the degree examination.

Credits for Graduation

The total credit requirements for graduate students shall be prescribed by respective graduate schools. Master's students shall at least complete 24 course credits and 6 thesis credits. Doctoral students shall at least complete 18 course credits and 12 thesis credits. As may be required for their researches, graduate students may enroll in the undergraduate courses; the scores will not be included in the total average of that semester and upon graduation, and the units will not be counted against the graduation requirements. * List of Credits for Graduation: <u>https://aps.ntut.edu.tw/course/en/Cprog.jsp?format=-2&vear=2021</u>

> <u>Dormitory Information</u>

New students of FALL Intake are eligible to apply to reside at Taipei Tech Dormitories for the **first 2 years** ONLY. Residence spaces at Taipei Tech Dormitories from the 3rd year onwards will be decided by lottery and not guaranteed to all. Students entering their 3rd year of study should be prepared to reside elsewhere.

Students who have requested for Taipei Tech dormitory spaces can move in the dormitories on the opening day (September 2). Students who arrive before the opening date will NOT be admitted to the dormitories and must arrange for their own accommodation until the dormitories are open.

Health & Insurance

International students must register for health insurance during their stay in Taiwan. Students staying in Taiwan with a valid Alien Resident Certificate (ARC) for over six months continuously must enroll in National Health Insurance (NHI). Prior to registering for NHI, we will automatically enroll you in Group Medical Insurance.

Note: If you would like to use another insurance that you have purchased from your home country instead of joining Group Medical Insurance, you must have the insurance verified by the Taiwan Embassy/Mission in your home country.

The Group Medical Insurance fee is a one-time payment.
