Credit Transfer / Waiver

Credit Transfer/Waiver by Repeated/Make-up Course:

Pursuant to Article 15 of the NTUT "Credit Transfer and Waiver Policy," if the mandatory course is cancelled, changes its name or credits, the preliminary review unit of credit transfer/waiver may offer a similar alternative subject to transfer students by school or major, students during the course replacement process or repeating/making up for that course. However, the total credits required for graduation remain the same according to the NTUT Academic Rules and cannot be reduced.

Credit Waiver of English Program

- ♦ Qualification for an eight credit exemption of English Courses:
- (1) Foreign student from native English-speaking countries can exempt language testing with approval from the Taipei Tech Department of English.
- (2) TOEIC score of 945 or higher. (Or CEFR Level on C1 Mastery)
- ♦ Qualification for a four credit exemption of English Courses:
- (1) Foreign students from non-native English-speaking countries can provide proof that English is the primary language of their formal education with approval from the Department of English.
- (2) TOEIC score of more than 800. (Or CEFR Level on B2 Effective Operational Proficiency)

Minimum English Proficiency Requirements for Graduation

Each student admitted to the four-year college of the day division from the Academic Year 2012 must meet one of the following English proficiency test criteria to pass the minimum English proficiency requirements for graduation:

- (1) NTUT "English Proficiency Test for Minimum Graduation Requirement" Level A or Level B.
- (2) Scoring in accordance with CEFR level B1 on English proficiency tests provided by reputable international or local institutions listed in Schedule 1 of I3.

IMPORTANT

Students are strongly advised to complete all tuition and payments before deadline. Students who fail to pay their tuition and fees before the deadline will be penalized in accordance with university regulations and face the consequences of expulsion and deportation.

Dormitory Information

New students of FALL Intake are eligible to apply to reside at Taipei Tech Dormitories for the **first 2 years** ONLY. Residence spaces at Taipei Tech Dormitories from the 3rd year onwards will be decided by lottery and not guaranteed to all. Students entering their 3rd year of study should be prepared to reside elsewhere.

Students who have requested for Taipei Tech dormitory spaces can move in the dormitories on the opening day (September 2). Students who arrive before the opening date will NOT be admitted to the dormitories and must arrange for their own accommodation until the dormitories are open.

Health & Insurance

International students must register for health insurance during their stay in Taiwan. Students staying in Taiwan with a valid Alien Resident Certificate (ARC) for over six months continuously must enroll in National Health Insurance (NHI). Prior to registering for NHI, we will automatically enroll you in Group Medical Insurance.

Note: If you would like to use another insurance that you have purchased from your home country instead of joining Group Medical Insurance, you must have the insurance verified by the Taiwan Embassy/Mission in your home country.

The Group Medical Insurance fee is a one-time payment.
