

國際處 × 北科 Oikos 團契 | 115 學年度學伴計畫轉接說明 Q&A

Q: 我要怎麼成為學伴？

A: 向國際處索取申請表並填寫完成繳交，確認錄取後配合 Oikos 團契社完成學伴訓練&外籍生活動籌備。

Q: 擔任學伴的服務時數與交換生的加分機制如何換算？

A: 學伴服務採計服務時數，並依國際處規定換算加分：服務時數達 10 小時可加 1 分、20 小時可加 2 分，以此類推，最高以 10 分為上限；實際認列方式依國際處公告為準。

Q: 如果已經參與過 Student Buddy，是否還需要重新報名？

A: 是的。請協助重新填寫表單，讓我們更新大家的基本資料與可配合時間，以利安排新學期學伴培訓及相關活動。

Q: Oikos 團契社與國際處有什麼差別？

A: 國際處主要負責學伴計畫公告、資格審核、服務時數認列及相關行政作業（並非每一項培訓課程皆可認列服務時數）。

Oikos 團契主要負責學伴培訓、活動支持與陪伴，以及協助學伴共同完成交換生活動及相關交流事項。

Q: 錄取學伴後是否代表加入 Oikos 團契？若與原本的社團衝突怎麼辦？

A: 錄取成為學伴後，即成為 Oikos 團契社的一員，社團會積極協助學伴共同完成學校賦予學伴的任務（例如：期初 Welcome Party、期中期末任務等）。

若成為學伴前已經是其他社團、系學會成員，因 Oikos 團契社的社課種類非常多元，不強制必須參加每一次社課，針對學伴計劃領域的訓練課程參與即可，學伴們可以自行評估課餘時間安排，但必須以完成學伴計劃為目標。

Q: 加入社團後一定要擔任社團幹部嗎？

A: Oikos團契社是一個注重生活感和傳承的社團，若在擔任學伴過程中真心感受到這個社團像家一樣的溫馨和歸屬感，也歡迎參與後續的幹部面試，把擔任學伴所獲得的經驗，透過服務行動分享給學弟妹。

Q: 學伴培訓是否為必要參與？

A: 是。為確保學伴能了解計畫內容、跨文化交流方式及活動執行流程，錄取後須配合完成Oikos 團契安排之學伴培訓及相關準備事項，作為參與學伴計畫的重要內容。

Q: How do I become a Student Buddy?

A: Please request the application form from the Office of International Affairs (OIA), fill it out, and submit it. Once your admission is confirmed, you will need to cooperate with the OIKOS NTUT Fellowship Club (OIKOS Fellowship) to complete buddy training and the preparation of activities for international students.

Q: How are the service hours and the bonus points for exchange student applications calculated?

A: Student Buddy service is recognized as service hours and converted into bonus points according to OIA regulations: 1 point is awarded for every 10 hours of service, 2 points for 20 hours, and so on, up to a maximum of 10 points. The actual recognition method is subject to the official announcement by the OIA.

Q: If I have already participated as a Student Buddy before, do I need to sign up again?

A: Yes. Please help us re-fill the form so that we can update everyone's basic information and availability. This will facilitate the arrangement of buddy training and related activities for the new semester.

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Q: What is the difference between the OIKOS Fellowship and the Office of International Affairs (OIA)?

A:

Office of International Affairs (OIA): Primarily responsible for Student Buddy program announcements, qualification screening, recognition of service hours, and related administrative operations (*not every training course is eligible for service hour recognition).

OIKOS Fellowship: Primarily responsible for buddy training, activity support, and companionship, as well as assisting buddies in jointly completing exchange student activities and related exchange matters.

Q: Does being admitted as a Student Buddy mean joining the OIKOS Fellowship? What if it conflicts with my current student club?

A: Once admitted as a Student Buddy, you become a member of the OIKOS Fellowship. The club will actively assist buddies in jointly completing the tasks assigned by the university (e.g., Orientation Welcome Party, mid-term, and final activities).

If you are already a member of another student club or department association before becoming a buddy, please note that because the OIKOS Fellowship offers a wide variety of club classes, mandatory attendance is not required for every single class. You only need to participate in the training courses relevant to the Student Buddy program. Buddies can evaluate and arrange their own free time, but must prioritize the goal of completing the Student Buddy program.

Q: Do I have to serve as a club officer after joining the club?

A: The OIKOS Fellowship cherishes the essence of life and heritage. If you align with our core values and feel a sense of belonging while being a Student Buddy, we warmly welcome you to join our officer interviews and pass this precious experience on to your juniors through acts of service

Q: Is participation in the Student Buddy training mandatory?

A: Yes. To ensure that buddies understand the program content, cross-cultural communication methods, and activity execution procedures, all admitted buddies are required to complete the training and preparation sessions organized by the OIKOS Fellowship. This serves as an essential component of participating in the Student Buddy program.
