

New qualifications applied to exchange programs at Kindai University

(School Year)

Please be informed that students who will be in the last semester of their last school year during our program period is no longer acceptable.

(Credits Transfer)

In addition to the school year regulation, only those who have the number of courses that is equivalent to our 7 courses minimum left to complete graduation requirement while on exchange are qualified as nominees.

This number of courses, 7, is defined based on Japanese government law; those who stay in Japan under "Student" visa need to study at school at least 10 hours per week and this 10 hours of study per week is equivalent to 7 courses at Kindai.

Credits converting calculation differs from each partner university, so please convert the hours of study per course at Kindai to your credits by your institution's own conversion system.

The total number of hours per course in one semester at Kindai is 45 hours. (Total number of hours of 7 courses is 315 hours.)

Please prepare the document that proves how many of your credits are given to our 45 hours of study/course and send it to us together with your nomination list.

Nomination list in our own format and application documents will be available within next month. We are going to send them to you as soon as they are ready. We apologize for the inconvenience this may cause you. Thank you for your patience.

(The number of semesters to attend)

Giving the chance to more broad range of students who choose us as their study abroad destination, Kindai University now puts more focus on accepting one semester students.

As for the nominees who request for two semesters, please note only those whom Kindai considers the necessity of one year of study in their major at Kindai from academic perspective, can be qualified.
