This fee will be used for student services, student council and the semester ticket that allows students to use all public transportation within Dresden and Saxony for free. Health Insurance	Facebook groups or www.wg-gesucht.de All students in Germany must be covered by a health insurance. When enrolling as a student at HTW Dresden, they must provide a proof of health insurance.
	Students from countries within the European Union (EU)/EFTA must apply for the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) in their native country and take it to Germany.
	Students from countries that do not belong to the European Union (EU)/EFTA must be insured immediately by a German statutory health insurance company (e.g. AOK, TK, Barmer) after arrival. https://www.htw-dresden.de/en/international/coming-to-htw-dresden/practical-information.html
Visa	Students from countries in the European Union, EFTA, Australia, Israel, Japan, Canada, Korea, New Zealand and the USA do not require a visa to enter Germany. A valid passport or personal identification is sufficient.
	Students from countries that are not in the European Union or EFTA require a study visa for their stay in Germany for academic purposes. Visa applications are to be submitted to the German Missions Office in their home country.
	All Students from non-EU countries who stay longer than three months are obliged to apply for a residency permit for academic purposes at the Immigration Authority of Dresden within the first three months after entering Germany.
