Academic Levels	Undergraduate and Graduate (Master Course) levels
Faculties	At the undergraduate level, we have six faculties of Humanities and Social Sciences, Education, Agriculture, Science, Engineering, and Informatics. The applicant's faculty will be decided on consultation between the Shizuoka University Organization for International Collaboration and each faculty, then the study plan shall be finalized. At the graduate (Master Course) level, we have three Graduate Schools of Humanities and Social Sciences, Education and Integrated Science and Technology.
Terms	Spring term : April 1 st ~ September 30 th Fall term : October 1 st ~ March 31 st You can choose between one term (6 months) or two terms (full year)
Japanese Language Studies	<p>Organization for International Collaboration provides Japanese language and culture classes for the international students from the beginner's level to the advanced level. The study plan will be confirmed after consulting with his/her faculty advisor and academic advisor. If you take these online classes, you will be officially recognized as exchange students at Shizuoka University and this will be included as part of your exchange program.</p>

Academic Studies	Most classes in the undergraduate level are given in Japanese. If an applicant would like to study his/her major and to take these classes, the high command of Japanese must be required. There are a few introductory courses given in English. The details will be offered at the orientation at the beginning of each term. At the graduate level, some courses in Agriculture, Science, Engineering and Informatics may be offered in English. All the courses in the Humanities and Social Sciences-and the Education are given in Japanese.
Obligation	All exchange students are under obligation to take classes for more than 7 classes (10 hours) per week.
Application	Application documents must arrive to us by 31th March 2022 through the applicant's University Office.
