Step one	<p>Nominate by Partner University</p> <p>We accept the students who have been selected and nominated by their home university, according to bilateral exchange agreements.</p>
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	<p>The home university selects and nominates student name list to Faculty of Architecture, Chulalongkorn University via email: Sansanee.w@chula.ac.th in which following information must be specified for each nominated student as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Name – Surname 2. Passport number 3. Nationality 4. Program of study 5. Duration of study (number of the semester and academic year) 6. Email address - please give us your students' correct and current email addresses (both personal and academic accounts)
Step two	<p>Online Application by Students</p> <p>After the coordinator has sent the nomination letter of the exchange students, the students will receive the instructions from the faculty via email. They are required to fill in and upload the supporting documents in the application form before the deadline. Without the required documents, the students' applications will not be accepted.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A passport photo on a white background 2. Two reference letters from academic advisors 3. An official academic transcript 4. An English proficiency score record 5. A copy of the first page of the passport (a copy of the biodata page) 6. A Statement of Purpose (SOP) of 500-800 words 7. A list of the courses that the students wish to attend (Wishlist)

	<p>8. The consent form of a COVID-19 infection prevention plan* and</p> <p>9. A medical certificate, an official health report, or proof of COVID-19 vaccinations. *</p> <p>*This depends on the COVID-19 situation during the actual exchange period and the decision of the COVID-19 Emergency Operation Center Committee of the University will be taken as the final verdict.</p>
Course credit	<p>The maximum course load per semester</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Undergraduate student: 22 credits - Graduate student: 15 credits <p>Note – At Chula, in lecturers, seminars, discussions, or other forms of instruction, 1 academic credit is equivalent to 1 hour of work per week or approximately 15 hours in a semester.</p>

Student visa application	<p>All students must apply for a student/education visa (Non-Immigrant Visa – ED) to come to study in Thailand. The OIA will provide them with a cover letter, a Certificate of Admission, and supporting documents for visa application, all of which will be sent to the International Office at the students' home institutions.</p> <p>In the application form, the applicants are required to fill in the address of the Royal Thai Embassy/Consulate in their current country of</p>

	<p>residence. If there is more than one address of the Royal Thai Embassy/Consulate in the students' resident countries, it is important that they choose which Royal Thai Embassy/Consulate they wish to submit their visa application. This is because the Royal Thai Embassy/Consulate address chosen by the students will appear in a cover letter, which is required by many Royal Thai Embassies/Consulates.</p> <p>To learn more about the addresses of the Royal Thai Embassies/Consulates worldwide, please refer to the official website provided by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs: www.thaiembassy.org</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The students' later change of their choice of the address of the Royal Thai Embassy/Consulate may result in a delay in their obtaining a visa application package. 2.
