#### Online Application by Students

After the coordinator has sent the nomination letter of the exchange students, the students will receive the instructions from the faculty via email. They are required to fill in and upload the supporting documents in the application form before the deadline. Without the required documents, the students' applications will not be accepted.

- 1. A passport photo on a white background
- 2. Two reference letters from academic advisors
- 3. An official academic transcript
- 4. An English proficiency score record
- 5. A copy of the first page of the passport (a copy of the biodata page)
- 6. A Statement of Purpose (SOP) of 500-800 words
- 7. A list of the courses that the students wish to attend (Wishlist)

	9. A medical certificate, an official health
	report, or proof of COVID-19 vaccinations. *

	Thailand. The OIA will provide them with a cover
	letter, a Certificate of Admission, and supporting
	documents for visa application, all of which will be
	sent to the International Office at the students'
	home institutions.
	In the application form, the applicants are required
	to fill in the address of the Royal Thai
	Embassy/Consulate in their current country of

residence. If there is more than one address of the Royal Thai Embassy/Consulate in the students' resident countries, it is important that they choose which Royal Thai Embassy/Consulate they wish to submit their visa application. This is because the Royal Thai Embassy/Consulate address chosen by the students will appear in a cover letter, which is required by many Royal Thai Embassies/Consulates.
