Step two	Online Application by Students
	After the coordinator has sent the nomination letter of
	the exchange students, the students will receive
	instructions from the faculty via email. They are required

	to fill in and upload the supporting documents in the
	application form before the deadline. Without the
	required documents, the students' applications will not
	be accepted.

	3. An official academic transcript (to be issued by
	the Registrar of the student's home university)
	4. An English proficiency score record
	5. A copy of the first page of the passport (a copy
	of the biodata page)

Being an exchange student on a valid student exchange
agreement, you will have <u>tuition fees waived by the host</u>
university [Chula]. However, during your exchange, you
will continue to pay tuition fees to your home university.
While participating in the student exchange program, you
will be expected to cover other expenses relating to

your exchange. All expenses you are expected to be responsible of include the following: Accommodation Travel Expenses Passport & Visa Costs Registration Fees / Administrative Fees Medical and Health Insurance Travel Insurance Vaccinations Student Uniforms [Undergraduate Level] Personal and Daily Living Expenses Any other incidental costs Group Health Insurance Fee for With reference to the Chulalongkorn University International Students Announcement on Group Health Insurance Fee for International Students, Academic Year 2021, stipulated on June 4, 2021. (Refer to Chulalongkorn University Announcement >> EN / TH) Each international students who enrolls in courses or research studies for at least one whole semester or more, will be required to pay Chula group health insurance fee of 2,000 THB per academic year, covering the period from 1st August to 31st July, and for both IPD and OPD patients. COVID-19 is also included. Payment method: CU NEX Application Chulalongkorn University International House Accommodation (CU-iHouse) Monthly rent (Studio 25 sq.m.) Available in both a single bedroom and a twin bedroom. – A contract for a 1-month to a 5-month stay: THB 15,000 (~USD490) per month – A contract for a 6-month to a 12-month stay: THB 14,000 (~USD450) per month Remark: one-month room deposit and one-month rental fee must be paid in advance

For those who would like to stay at CU iHouse, our oncampus accommodation, please make a reservation via CU-iHouse at least 45 days before your arrival.

Due to the high demands of on-campus accommodation, please note that it is not guaranteed that there will be a vacancy for you.

Student visa application

All students must apply for a student/education visa (Non-Immigrant Visa – ED) to come to study in Thailand. The OIA will provide them with a cover letter, a Certificate of Admission, and supporting documents for visa application, all of which will be sent to the International Office at the students' home institutions.

In the application form, the applicants are required to fill in the address of the Royal Thai Embassy/Consulate in their current country of residence. If there is more than one address of the Royal Thai Embassy/Consulate in the students' resident countries, it is important that they choose which Royal Thai Embassy/Consulate they wish to submit their visa application. This is because the Royal Thai Embassy/Consulate address chosen by the students will appear in a cover letter, which is required by many Royal Thai Embassies/Consulates.
