2. The 30 ECTS minor programmes at the Wibaut Building may have a different academic planning, check with the minor coordinator.
3. It is not possible to miss out on the start of the semester. Studying at AUAS requires mandatory participation in all lessons.
4. End semester: the official last day of the semester is up to and including the date mentioned.
5. The rental period for housing is for a fixed period. It is not possible to get a refund if you arrive in Amsterdam later, or if you leave before the end of your rental period.
