Each exchange programme has its own specific admission requirements. You can find these on the exchange programme page under the header "practical matters – admission requirements" or you can click on the link in the second column.

Also, please be aware that we can't always guarantee that students will be accepted to their 1st programme preference (e.g. due maximum capacity programmes or not meeting the requirements based on study background). Therefore we will ask your students to indicate their programme preferences in the online application form: 1st, 2nd and 3rd preference. If we have to ask students to transfer to another (similar) programme, we will contact you and the student(s) as soon as possible during or shortly after the application period. Students, and partners, will be informed about the student's acceptance within 3 weeks after the application deadline.

COVID-19: course format

Students are expected to move to Rotterdam for their exchange as all exchange programmes will be offered on campus. Students who have been accepted for an exchange at Rotterdam UAS have to be aware that the COVID-19 situation can still change. If the situation gets worse in the coming months (some) programmes might switch to a blended or online format.
