Guest students are expected to prove a B1 German Level for courses taught in German, in some Departments a B2 level is needed.

# Costs and Funding

All students at FH Münster have to pay a social contribution of around €300 per semester. This includes a ticket for public transport valid throughout all of North Rhine-Westphalia.
