## Visa Requirements

- Students are advised to obtain Student Visa from the Embassy of India before arriving to India.
- Exchange students are not allowed to work, whether paid or unpaid.

## Insurance

- It is mandatory for exchange students to have insurance.
- Students are required to get themselves insured against any eventuality at their own cost for the period of stay at IIT Delhi and will have to submit a copy of the Insurance cover at the time of joining.

## Important Points

- Incoming students are required to submit their Curriculum Vitae, Motivation Letter and consolidated transcript by email or by post.
- Arrangements are made for airport pick-ups.
