Mandatory Residence Registration with Municipal Department 62 (MA 62)	<p>According to Austrian law, you have to register with the authorities. Here you can find which documents you need and further information that you should consider. The registration with MA62 is relevant for all incoming students. The registration form (<i>Meldezettel</i>) is available only in German. An English version that will help you fill in the form will be provided during the Orientation Week.</p>
Residence Registration with Municipal Department 35 (MA 35)	<p>Students with EU/EEA or Swiss nationality who are staying in Austria for more than 3 months have to apply for a confirmation of registration (<i>Anmeldebescheinigung</i>) within four months of arrival. Further information about the required documents and fees can be found here.</p>
