MOE-Elite Scholarship



Eligibility

Qualification of international students who are Doctoral/Master's degree-seeking applicants, and currently are university lecturers or professors in Indonesia, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam, India, Malaysia, Singapore, Brunei, Myanmar, Cambodia, Laos, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Bhutan and all African countries.

- *Up-to-date Lecturer Certificate (English version) is required.
- *Only newly admitted students can apply. Current students at NTUT cannot apply.
- **Students may not apply if they:
- Hold Taiwan (R.O.C.) nationality or have the status of an overseas Chinese student.
- Are enrolled or have retained admission to a university in Taiwan. (This restriction does not apply to students who are on course to graduate and will be pursuing their next degree; however, they must still be a lecturer from a South or Southeast Asian country.)
- Previously studied in Taiwan for a degree at the same level.
- Are exchange students or dual-degree students through a partnership agreement with an institution overseas.
- Has already received stipends through this program for more than three years.
- Have been awarded by foreign governmental institutions or scholarships from a Taiwan (R.O.C.) government agency to support their studies in Taiwan.

Duration of Scholarship

- ◆ Ph.D. programs: 3 years (reviewed annually/ available to renew and transfer to NTUT International Graduate Student Scholarship in the 4th year)
- ◆ Master programs: 2 years (reviewed annually)

Application Period

After admission result is announced (after you got <u>accepted</u> by NTUT), NTUT will inform all accepted PhD students from South-East and South Asian Countries and African Countries the MOE-Elite Scholarship application details.

Qualified students must send the **up-to-date Lecturer Certificate (English version)** to NTUT by the designated deadline.

- *MOE-Elite for new PhD students from **South-East and South Asian Countries** is only available in Fall semester. (Limited slots available)
- *MOE-Elite for new PhD students from **African Countries** is available in Fall and Spring semesters. (Limited slots available)

Amount of Scholarship

The amount of the scholarship is issued by MOE, and it will be NTD 300,000 per year per person, which is used as funding for your tuition fee and credit fee, and the rest amount will be used as a monthly stipend to support your study and living in NTUT.

*So the amount of your monthly stipend will be around NTD13,000~15,000.

Remarks

- 1. Recipients are NOT allowed to receive NTUT International Graduate Student Scholarship during the offered period of this scholarship at the same time.
- 2. Applicants must complete their enrollment procedures at NTUT in order to receive the monthly stipend.
- 3. Scholarship will be canceled if recipients apply for a deferment, suspension, exchange program, dual degree, or get expelled from enrolled programs.
- 4. The Scholarship is determined by the Ministry of Education, with a limited number of slots available. Application does not guarantee approval.
